CHALLENGE

As part of their preservation duties, Archive staff were asked to organize and incorporate new and existing material from 5 major departments throughout the company.

Combining all this information into one system presented a challenge. The material was spread out both physically and electronically across multiple departments and various storage media.

Access to some of the documents required a higher security clearance and most material, if not all, had to be available at a moment's notice.

Archive staff also wanted a solution that would allow for a diverse number of documents, custom file types, images and more to be stored in one place.

Finally, it was very important that RE's engineers and Archive team quickly and easily find what they needed.

SOLUTION
